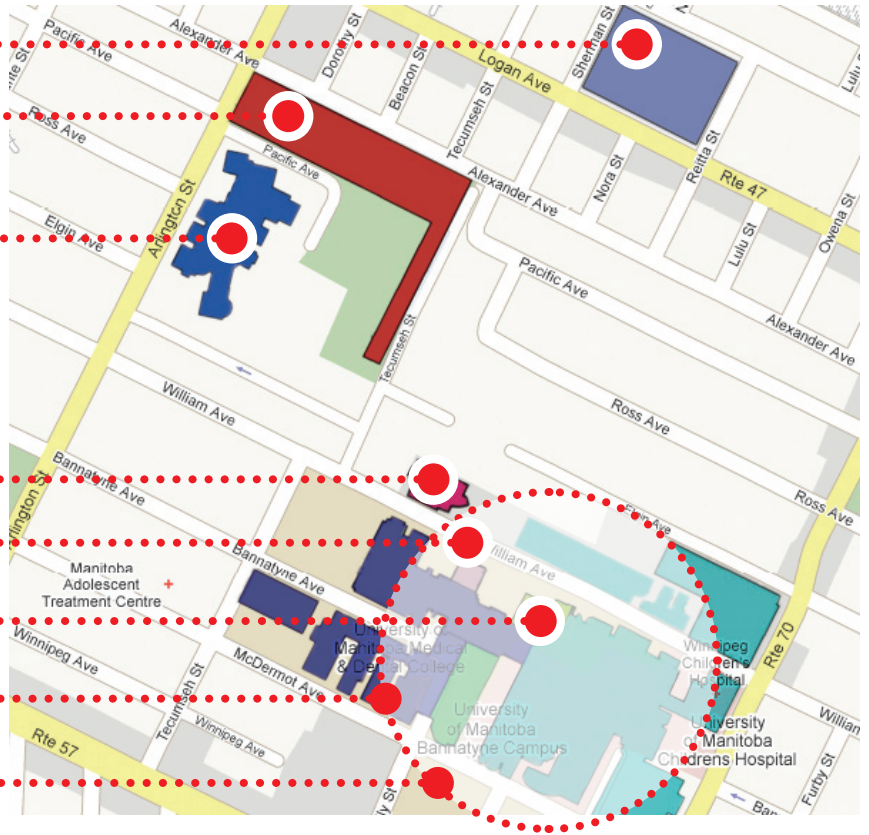

1. Future HIV Vaccine Research Centre
A proposed HIV vaccine research centre of excellence.

2. Proposed Site - CHVI/ICID Vaccine Manufacturing Facility
5.2 acres of land, currently vacant.

3. Canadian Science Centre for Human and Animal Health (CSCHAH)
The CSCHAH is Canada's leading and largest public health infectious disease facility, with an annual budget of \$50 million and 500 staff.

It is home to the National Microbiology Laboratory (NML), Public Health Agency of Canada, and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA).

The CFIA's National Centre for Foreign Animal Disease provides state-of-the art scientific expertise

and technologies for the prevention, detection, control and reporting of Foreign Animal Disease.

4. Canadian Blood Services
Not-for-profit charitable organization that collects and tests 850,000 units of blood annually for infectious diseases.

5. Cadham Provincial Laboratory
Provides a range of diagnostic, reference and consultative services to Manitoba and beyond.

6. Siemens Institute for Advanced Medicine (SIAM) - An 80,000 sq. ft. facility (slated to open in 2010) will test new healthcare techniques and surgical technologies, researching advances in infectious diseases, neurological sciences and neurosurgery.

7. U of M Faculty of Medicine
U of M Medical school has 250 faculty members and \$120-million in external research grants, departments of Immunology, Medical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases. It is co-located with the Health Sciences Centre.

8. Health Sciences Centre (HSC)
HSC is a healthcare referral, teaching and research centre serving Manitoba, North-West Ontario and Nunavut, and one of the largest facilities of its kind in Canada. It is the dedicated trauma centre for Manitoba, and performs research into infectious diseases and clinical trials.

Winnipeg is home to the largest concentration of HIV researchers in Canada.
